Please be informed that based on board approved resolution under **Conditional Certification No. CC-21-065** the following are included or reflected in the port tariff.

- The said board resolution is for the implementation of 20% rate adjustment for cargo handling of containerized cargo in two (2) tranches.
 - First Tranche of ten percent (10%) on May 30, 2021**
 - Second Tranche of another ten percent (10%) on September 30, 2021**
- Rationalize the existing Tariff structure for containerized cargoes by matching or adopting Ports of Manila and Batangas tariff items that are currently not present or competitive in the existing Subic bay Tariff effective upon Board approval. However, only tariffs/ fees that were identified during the public hearing or included in the Management's Power Point Presentation shall be included, to wit:
