Dear SBITC valued clients,

In lieu of hard copies of Container Release Orders (CRO), CROs will be digitally validated by your respective carriers starting October 24 (Monday).

Upon payment of terminal charges, SBITC customers will no longer be required to present hard copy of the Container Release Order granted that the Electronic Container Released Order (eCRO) is valid.

## Reminders:

- 1. Electronic Container Release Order (eCRO) via Navis will replace hardcopy presented upon payment of terminal charges.
- 2. eCRO will be updated by the carrier if the consignee has no outstanding impediments. In case of any changes, carriers may adjust or revoke applied eCRO validity.
- 3. eCRO validation will happen upon truck entry at SBITC. Truck transacting for containers with valid eCRO may enter and complete transaction at the terminal. However, any container impediments, including eCRO validity, will prohibit trucks from entering.

Kindly disseminate to your team to avoid any disruption to cargo movement.
